#### Letter from the Post Commander:

**T**his year's newsletter is going to be very different than those of the past few years. Many changes which are necessary for our survival are in the works. Some of you may agree with me and others may not.

Before I begin addressing these issues, I need to tell everyone that due to my recent illness and hospitalization, I will be stepping down in October as your Post Commander. After eighteen years as Commander, it is time for someone else to step up and fill this position. I am very proud of all of the things we, as an organization has accomplished over these years and there are many, far too many to list here. But, these couldn't have been done without the great Veteran and Auxiliary officers who served under me, along with our entire group of Veteran, Auxiliary and Social members I hope our Post tradition of serving God, Veterans and local Community will continue.

The Executive Board recently reviewed our business expenses for the period of 2020 thru 2024. During that time our annual income has decreased by approximately \$30,000. During this same period, expenses rose by over 20%. Much of this is due to the utility and insurance rate increases, but also the lack of our hall rentals and declining membership. An example of this to ponder is: if **one person** who spends \$50 a week at our bar either stops coming to our post or dies, how do we make up \$50 X 52 weeks= \$2,600. The lost revenue increases even more if family and friends who frequented the Post or events with this individual also stopped attending. We have had several occurrences like this over the past five years.

Bringing in new members and supporting our functions is the only way the Post can raise money to keep our C.W.V. programs and business operations going.

If you want Post 1562 and its Auxiliary to continue, you all need to get involved, volunteer some of your time, attend our events and meetings and help us recruit new members. The Auxiliary slate of officer is full but there are vacancies on the Veterans side for individuals to step forward to take the responsibility and accountability of an Officer.

A few weeks ago, I called a meeting of all members to come to our annual planning meeting. We had a very aggressive agenda and have added a few new events which we believe will help our Post and Auxiliary to raise funds. We also eliminated past events which were not too successful.

Our 2025 calendar of events is contained in this newsletter. Because all of details of these events are not known (time and prices) I encourage everyone to periodically check our website: <a href="https://www.CWV-Post1562.org">www.CWV-Post1562.org</a> and to provide the Post or Auxiliary a valid Email so you can receive periodic "MAILCHIMP" messages with updates for Post and Auxiliary meetings and events.

The Executive Board has authorized a FIFTY cents increase for **All** drink prices at the bar effective February 1, 2025. In addition, the Blue, Yellow, Orange, Black and White colored drink tokens (Bar chips) which have been in use for many years *will no longer be accepted* effective on January 1, 2026. New drink tokens, respective to the price increase, are on back-order and will be used once they arrive.

The Executive Board also authorized Hall Rental price increases effective February 1, 2025. Non-Member rental is \$400; Member rental is \$150. The rental agreement will be strictly enforced as stated: Members who are renting on behalf of relatives who are NOT the Immediate Family will be charged the Non-Member rate of \$400.

It is important to attend the monthly business meetings. There has been misinformation being spread in the bar from people who do not attend meetings and think they know everything because they hear others tell half-truths.

The truth is that we have four key fund raisers throughout the year of which any money raised (profit wise) will go to them. Those are for House of Heroes – Connecticut in March, the Naval Sea Cadets Barque Eagle Division in June, and Tunnel to Towers in September and for the youth sports programs at St. Mary / St. Michael School in October. All other proceeds from raffles, dinners, 50/50, donations, jukebox, game machine and pool table and the like are used for general expenses, and the High School Scholarship Fund. Beginning in 2025 we will be earmarking some funds to pay down additional principal on the commercial load taken out to build the outdoor patio. We also put \$50 aside each week to help members who may attend the CWV National Convention (capped at a re-imbursement up to \$500).

We will be having a dinner this year to help raise funds to purchase new instruments for the St. Mary / St. Michael Fife & Drum Band. Our Veteran 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice Commander Maureen McDonald introduced this at the school, and it has nurtured the excitement of many students who wish to take part in this patriotic musical experience.

As mentioned above, there are several Veteran (Post) officer positions which remain vacant and need to be filled so others are not dual hatted where things slip through the cracks – or worse case is that the responsibilities of the office are not being carried out at all. Having all of these officer positions filled allows each officer to properly do their own jobs; because others are not multi-tasking trying to accomplish everything. Most positions only take about an hour or two of your time per month, so please step forward and help out. Specific vacancies and opportunities include: maintaining the www.CWV-Post1562.org website, photographing events for publicity, Post Welfare Officer, Post Historian, Director and backup for the Post Treasurer. There are also several officer positions open within the CWV Department of Connecticut echelon which meets four times per year here at Post 1562.

With over 400 members between the Veterans, Auxiliary and Social member rosters, there are plenty of individuals in our ranks to become actively involved. More volunteers are needed to help with the events we hold during the year. There will be a sign-up sheet on the post bulletin board to volunteer for a committee / event. Examples would be: setting up and breakdown of events, building and decorating the parade float, volunteering to work at MEATO's, planned BBQs, Dinners, the Outing and general maintenance.

One of our primary responsibilities is as Catholics is to practice our faith. Please consider attending our Annual Corporate Communion Mass at St. Michael's Church across the street from the Post on Sunday, April 6, 2025. The church changed the time of its Sunday morning Mass to 9:00 AM so it's an hour earlier than usual – so please make a sacrifice to change your daily routine (if you're not an early bird) to attend.  $\rightarrow$  IF YOU HAVE a CWV / CWVA dress uniform or any Post 1562 or Auxiliary attire please wear it so our group is recognized at the church. If not – that's okay - it's your attendance that counts. Per tradition - there will be a delicious brunch cooked by the Paugy firemen and others, served in the Post Hall followed by a short speaking and recognitions program. Social members are welcomed to Mass & Brunch.

My 2025 Commander Award recipient is JAMIE PURO who has been a great asset to me during the past year given my physical limitations. Congratulations JAMO!

If you have not provided us with your email, please send to our Email shown in the letterhead. We like to email because postage, envelopes, paper and labels is expensive. And although we do not have a dedicated Webmaster, there is one individual who tries to keep the website current. Bookmark it!

The bottom line is; if we all don't get involved, take things seriously and start bringing in new members or outsiders to our events, it's just a few years before we too will fold. This post is only as good as the people who support it and what we stand for. Please try to find some time to get involved.


